Things to Know About Summer Camp:

Signing up for Camp is first come, first serve. If you change your mind about weeks, you will lose your \$30 registration fee unless I can move you to another week that is open.

1. Summer Camp is 5 days a week unless noted under dates. (Closed July 3rd)
2. Each child will bring a lunch and a drink each day that will be refrigerated and heated as needed. Each child will also bring a backpack with a change of clothes to be kept on their own hook throughout the week.
3. Each child will bring a water bottle with their name on it.
4. Time of camp is 8:30-2pm. Of course you may come any time, but our group time begins at 9:10am.
5. We have a maximum of 24 children each week. We usually divide the children into two age groups in order to be more "hands on" with them.
6. Our daily schedule is the same each week but the theme of the camp changes. This helps our children to enjoy a routine along with the fun!
7. We open to the general public on March 31.

1:30-1:50pm	Wrap up the Day: Dancing, Group Time
1:50-2:00pm	Dismissal
